## EDS IN THE COMMUNITY

EDS' community activities center on improving the education of future generations and making our communities stronger. We support these initiatives by encouraging employee volunteerism and making monetary and in-kind contributions to nonprofit organizations. Because we believe in the importance of physical and mental health to succeed, half of EDS' donations go to health and human services organizations and nearly 40 percent to education projects.

In 2007, EDS employees gave approximately 135,000 hours of community service to the initiatives that are important to them. According to U.S. labor statistics, one volunteer hour is worth \$18.05, which would place the value of these volunteer hours at more than \$2.4 million.

### EDS Programs

**Education Outreach:** Since 1989, EDS Education Outreach has enhanced the lives of many thousands of students worldwide. The goal of the program is to help our young generation become productive, contributing members of society. We do this by combining voluntary, hands-on employee involvement and state-of-the-art technology to foster a joy of learning and improve the quality of education. Globally, EDS maintains partnerships with more than 100 schools.

**EDS Technology Grants:** EDS recognizes that future innovation will depend on a new generation of engineers. That's why the EDS Technology Grant Program provides more than 100 technology grants each year to elementary and secondary schools around the world for the purchase of technology products and services. To date, EDS has awarded more than \$2 million in technology grants.

**EDS Global Volunteer Day (GVD):** Good corporate citizenship is a key value at EDS. Our employees practice this philosophy in the community by participating in our annual Global Volunteer Day each October. More than 500,000 hours have been donated to this activity since it began in 1993.

**EDS United Way Campaign:** For more than 30 years, EDS employees have demonstrated their caring spirit by giving generously to the United Way and its agencies worldwide, making a substantial difference to community operations sustained through voluntary contributions.

**EDS Global Hunger Drive:** In 2006, EDS began a partnership with the nonprofit organization Aidmatrix to provide employees with the online tool to make donations to eligible food banks around the world. Using this system enables individual food banks to increase their buying power tremendously and to convert a \$1 donation into a \$15 purchase of food. To date, employees have donated nearly \$100,000, which is the equivalent of \$1.5 million worth of food.



## Contributions

**Corporate Contributions:** As part of our corporate citizenship, EDS supports nonprofit organizations through cash and in-kind contributions. In addition to thousands of employee volunteer hours, EDS has donated more than \$79 million to nonprofits and neighborhood schools around the world since it became an independent company in 1996.

**The EDS Foundation:** The EDS Foundation funds programs addressing education, technology solutions, arts and culture, and health and human services. The foundation has awarded \$4.8 million in grants to 95 nonprofits since it was established in 2000.

## Sponsorships

**EDS Byron Nelson Championship:** The PGA Tour event benefits the Salesmanship Club Youth and Family Centers, a nonprofit organization that provides mental health and education services to families. In addition to our sponsorship, EDS employee volunteers help staff the Championship. Since 1973, the Championship has raised more than \$100 million for charity, more than any other PGA Tour event.

**Komen Foundation:** EDS is committed to the Komen Foundation's fight against breast cancer and is a presenting sponsor for the Komen North Texas Race for the Cure® for which it raised more than \$31 million in 2007. EDS also supports the National Race for the Cure®, as well as other local affiliates, including the European-sponsored race in Frankfurt, Germany, through contributions, events, walking teams and technology.

**Nobel Prize Series:** As a global sponsor of the Nobel Prize Series, and the official technology services provider to Nobelprize.org, EDS is working with the Nobel Prize Series team to develop educational programs that raise awareness of science and technology, provide process support of Nobelprize.org, assist Nobel Media in broadening its marketing and media networks, support the placement of Nobel content on television networks, and collaborate on thought leadership projects.

## Other Community Programs

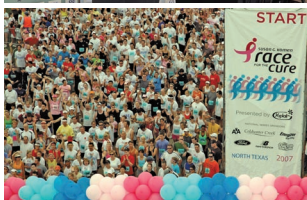
**March of Dimes:** In 2007, the company and its employees donated more than \$120,000 in support of the March of Dimes.

**Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation:** Since 2001, EDS and its employees have donated almost \$1 million in support of this cause.

**Children's Miracle Network:** EDS Top Gun consultants and integrators donated more than 360 hours to assist the Children's Miracle Network team with the rewriting and implementation of a software that allows member hospitals to interact; share ideas, documents and announcements; and so forth. By assisting a nonprofit organization, EDS' people also foster their own growth.

**Digital Pipeline:** EDS facilitated the donation of 30,000 PCs to needy children in Africa through the nonprofit group Digital Pipeline. This rigorous task required refurbishment of each machine in compliance with environmental regulations and disposal procedures. Launched by EDS Agility Alliance partner Microsoft, EDS is the largest donor.
